CERT – the Community Emergency Response Team – is a federally funded and locally operated program to teach citizens how to help themselves, their family, and their neighbors in a disaster when professional emergency responders are not immediately available.

Training will be held Mondays from 9am until noon beginning January 14<sup>th</sup> and will continue until March 25<sup>th</sup>.
